purpose The Piedmont Symphony Orchestra is proud to present its 2009 music camp. Campers will have the opportunity to explore a range of repertoire and build strong string ensemble performance skills in a challenging yet fun environment with students and staff from their own community.

musical activity Campers will participate daily (9:00AM – 2:00PM) in one of two core ensembles: Intermediate Orchestra – generally for rising grades 6-8 and Advanced Orchestra – generally for rising grades 9-11. Each core ensemble will spend the week preparing for a final concert the last day of camp. In addition to core ensembles, campers will have the opportunity to explore musical electives in areas like percussion, guitar and music theory. There will also be a number of camp-wide activities such as guest performers, workshops, movies, and camp-wide games.

staff The faculty and staff of the camp are primarily composed of current and former members of the Piedmont Regional Orchestra.

location All camp activities will take place at the current home of the Piedmont Regional Orchestra, the Highland Center for the Arts located at Highland School in Warrenton Virginia. This new, state of the art, facility offers campers the opportunity to rehearse and perform in a space of professional caliber.
